## 6.1.2 – The governing body implements an action plan, in partnership with Indigenous partners, to address Indigenous-specific systemic racism in the organization.

- 1. What partnerships has HDH developed to address Indigenous-specific systemic racism?
- Partnerships include: SOAHAC, Aboriginal Navigators, Diane Giroux, and Indigenous Elder.
- These relationships support cultural safety, Indigenous-led response, and reconciliation priorities.

#### 4.1.2 – The governing body maintains records of its activities and decisions.

- 1. What mechanisms are in place to ensure the Board maintains accurate records of its meetings and decisions?
- Use of Board Portal for secure documentation.
- Governance guided by Roberts Rules of Order and Board By-Laws.

## 4.2.1 – The governing body regularly evaluates its effectiveness, to make improvements as needed.

- 1. How does the Board assess its overall effectiveness?
- Tools include: Board effectiveness survey, Board meeting evaluations, OHA survey, skills matrix, Policy 311 Evaluation of Board Performance, and peer evaluations.
- Results inform governance development and succession planning.

# 3.3.3 – The governing body ensures that the organization establishes procedures to regularly evaluate the performance of clinical service providers who have been granted privileges.

- 1. How does the Board ensure there are procedures in place to regularly evaluate the performance of professional staff who have been granted privileges?
- Credentialing guided by Professional By-Laws Sections 4.1 and 4.2.
- Credentials approved by the Board, with Chief of Staff evaluations and a common credentialing process.

### 3.3.4 – The governing body ensures that the organization establishes procedures to appeal decisions regarding privileges.

- 1. What is the process if a professional staff member wishes to appeal a decision regarding their privileges?
- Appeals follow the Hospital Act and are detailed in the Professional By-Laws.
- Governed by the Public Hospitals Act, ensuring procedural fairness.

#### 3.4.1 – The governing body monitors the workforce's experiences in the workplace.

- 1. How does the Board monitor the experiences of the hospital workforce?
- Oversight by Finance/Audit Committee, external auditors, and review of financial reports.
- Policies on expenses and purchasing ensure transparency and accountability.

### 3.5.10 – The governing body ensures that the organization promotes environmental stewardship in its operations.

- 1. How does the Board promote environmental stewardship within hospital operations?
- Conservation and Demand Management Plan is part of the Operational Plan.
- Updates on initiatives (e.g., recycling Styrofoam) are shared with the Board.

## 3.5.7 – The governing body ensures that the organization protects the privacy and confidentiality of all stakeholder information.

- 1. What policies guide the protection of stakeholder privacy and confidentiality?
- Governed by PHIPA, Policy 306 Confidentiality of Board Business and Affairs, and Policy 307
   Patient Confidentiality.
- Regular audits and training reinforce compliance.
