Position Summary

Hospitalists are responsible for providing comprehensive inpatient care as the Most Responsible Physician (MRP) for admitted patients. Physicians work collaboratively with nursing, allied health professionals, specialists, primary care providers, and community partners to ensure safe, effective, and patient-centred care throughout the patient journey.

Responsibilities

- Admit, assess, and manage hospitalized medical patients on site
- Provide daily inpatient care and participate in multidisciplinary rounds
- Coordinate consultations and collaborate with specialist services
- Develop and implement treatment and discharge plans
- Ensure timely and accurate documentation
- Participate in quality improvement and patient safety initiatives
- Support patient flow and transition planning

Qualifications

- Independent licensure or eligibility for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
- Certification in Family Medicine (CCFP) and/or relevant hospital medicine experience
